Click here for the details regarding the online written test:

The details for the online written test are as follows:

- 1) The shortlisted candidates will be allowed to take the test/examination as per the allocated schedule for the respective courses
- 2) Candidates are required to have a Laptop/Desktop with an embedded Camera / separate Web Cam unit or a mobile phone for appearing for the test. **Please note that this is mandatory. Note that in case you do not have a Web Camera/mobile camera, you will not be able to take the test.**
- 3) Although candidates may attempt the test using a Mobile Phone, it is advised that laptop/desktop is used for the same.
- 4) Laptops / Desktops with Windows OS- Windows 7 and above are preferred. Candidates **should not use** Mac OS or any other OS.
- 5) Please make sure that your Laptop/mobile phone is fully charged before appearing for the test as a measure against unexpected power outages.
- 6) There will be a mock test for the shortlisted candidates for the Written Test and the date will be intimated.
- 7) Candidates are required to upload their images along with the image of a valid Photo Identity Card issued by the Government. Only after receiving approval, the candidates will be able to proceed further. **(Candidate Manual shall be provided)**
- 8) An online Proctor will be monitoring your test throughout the entire duration. Proctor can Pause your test, Take Snapshot remotely and Chat with you in case of any suspicious activity. The online examination system bears Artificial Intelligence (AI) features which will be continuously monitoring the candidates during the entire duration of test. It will continuously view your Live Video, your Images and the Screens of your Laptop/Desktop/mobile phone.
- 9) Please note that for answering the questions, the candidates may either use the Text Box space given below the questions to type the answer, or write on white ruled A4 sheets with bright blue/black ink which can then be scanned and uploaded. For the candidates attempting in Hindi, it is mandatory to answer for long-answer questions on white ruled A4 sheets, handwritten with bright blue/black ink. The answers are to be scanned and uploaded. **Blurred images shall not be evaluated.**
- 10) Please ensure that you are seated alone in a room for taking the tests. Also ensure that you are seated in a **well illuminated area and facing the camera properly** for taking the test.
- 11) Please make sure you make the final submission only after completing the test. You will be asked to confirm in case you accidentally try submitting the test before the completion of the duration. Please note that once you make the final submission, you will not be able to take up the test again.
- 12) The contact details of the Technical Support Team will be intimated to all the shortlisted candidates which may be used in case of any technical issue during the test.
