The committee formation are as follows:


1. Dean (Academic Affairs) & HOD (History of Art)

The NMI has a "zero tolerance" policy against ragging. The Hon'ble Supreme Court of India has defined ragging as "any disorderly conduct whether by words spoken or written or by an act which has the effect of teasing, treating or handling with rudeness any junior student, indulging in rowdy or in disciplined activities which causes or is likely to cause annoyance, hardship or psychological harm or to raise fear or apprehension thereof in a fresher or a junior student or asking the student(s) to do any act or perform something which the student will not do in a ordinary course and which has the effect of causing or generating a sense of shame or embarrassment so as to adversely affect the physique or psyche of a fresher or a junior student."

Ragging in any form is strict prohibited at NMI. All students are requested to adhere the stipulations/ provisions mentioned in the directions and fill the online undertaking through the websites (www.antiragging.in and www.amanmovement.org).
