Applications are invited for three positions of Research Assistants in the Department of Art Conservation, purely on temporary/contractual basis, fixed-term contract at a consolidated remuneration of Rs.38000/- per month for the following three projects (one position for each project):

The essential and desirable qualifications for these projects are as under:

Project 1: Technical studies on materials and techniques of Indian wall paintings

Project 2: Technical studies on fibres and dyes in historic textiles

Essential Qualifications:

- i. Postgraduate degree in Art Conservation/Conservation Science from a recognized university with minimum 55 % or equivalent marks.
- ii. Undergraduate degree in pure/applied sciences/engineering from a recognized university.
- iii. Excellent research and scientific writing skills.

Desirable Qualifications:

- i. Excellent command in computer applications, especially in analysis and interpretation of scientific data.
- ii. Good knowledge of photography and use of image editing software.

Project 3: Setting up and maintaining the conservation laboratory

Essential Qualifications:

- i. Postgraduate degree in Art Conservation from a recognized university with minimum 55 % or equivalent marks.
- ii. Knowledge of operation and maintenance of general laboratory equipment.
- iii. Knowledge of computer applications.

Age limit:

Maximum 40 years on the last date of issue of this advertisement. Relaxation for deserving candidates, if any, shall be at the sole discretion of the competent authority.

It is amply clarified that above engagement will be purely temporary and contractual, initially for a period of one year, extendable for one more year or up to the completion of the projects (subject to satisfactory performance of the candidate).
