ENGAGEMENT OF FACULTY ON CONTRACT BASIS

Department of Palaeography, Epigraphy & Numismatics

Applications are invited from eligible candidates suitable for the Department of Palaeography, Epigraphy & Numismatics, National Museum Institute, as faculty at the position of Assistant Professor on a purely contract basis, initially for a period of one year, extendable up to three years.

Essential Qualification :

- A Master's Degree with a minimum of 55% marks (or an equivalent grade on a point - scale wherever the grading system is followed) in Archaeology/ History & allied subjects.

OR

- A Master's Degree with minimum of 55% marks (or an equivalent grade on a point - scale wherever the grading system is followed) and PG diploma in Archaeology/ Palaeography/ Epigraphy/ Numismatics from an Indian University or an equivalent degree from a reputed foreign university.
- Besides fulfilling the above qualifications, the candidate must have cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET) conducted by the UGC or the CSIR, or a similar test accredited by the UGC, such as SLET/SET. Candidates who are or have been awarded a Ph.D. degree in accordance with the University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedure for the award of M.Phil./Ph.D. degree) Regulations and their amendments from time to time may be exempted from NET/SLET/SET.

Desirable Qualifications:

- A minimum of two years of working experience in teaching /or research/or fieldwork preferably in premier educational industry/ working experience in relevant sector i.e., Archaeology/ Palaeography/ Epigraphy and Numismatics.
- The incumbent should be passionate about teaching, agile in his/her approach, enjoy student interaction, networking with the industry partners and acknowledge the emerging trend related to vocational education and skill development.

Salary: The candidates appointed on a contract basis will be paid Basic pay in Academic Pay Level-10 + applicable DA.

Age: Not to exceed 45 years on the closing date of this advertisement.
