The abstract in English should be within 300 words in Times New Roman font, font size 12. For Hindi, Kruti Deo 10 font size 14 or Kokila Unicode font size 16 may be used. The abstract should include the title of the paper,

key words, main findings, the name of the author and the institution of affiliation, e-mail ID . A short bio-data of the author(s), not exceeding half a typed page, should also be sent along with the abstract. The final decision on the acceptance of abstracts lies with the Editorial Board. ➤ **Points to be taken note of:**

1. Paper presentation at the IAHC Conference is open to members (either Annual Members or Lifetime Members) only. Non-members are requested to become annual members of IAHC to present their papers at the conference.
2. Only Members/participants who send their registration Fee (as mentioned above) on or before 30<sup>th</sup>November 2024 will be considered official delegates of the conference, and the food and accommodation facility will be restricted to them.

3. Last-minute submission of abstracts and registration fees can be accommodated, in unavoidable circumstances, but in such cases, the participants will have to arrange their accommodations with no guarantee that their abstracts will be included in the printed form of Abstracts.
4. Participants are requested to submit their full papers on, or before the 30<sup>th</sup> of November 2024.
5. During the conference period, local transportation facilities for outstation participants to reach the conference venue, i.e. IIH from the place of their accommodation will be arranged.
6. The accommodation will be arranged from 7<sup>th</sup> February 2025 up to the afternoon of 11<sup>th</sup> February 2025 (4 nights). For outstation delegates joining the excursion/siteseeing, food and accommodation facilities will be extended up to the afternoon of 12<sup>th</sup> February 2025. However, they would be required to bear the expenses of accommodation and food.

➤ **About the Institution:**

The Indian Institute of Heritage (formerly the National Museum Institute of the History of Art, Conservation, and Museology) is a Deemed to be University under the Ministry of Culture, Government of India. The Institute was formed and registered on January 27, 1989, under the Societies Registration Act, 1860, and was accorded the status of 'Deemed to be University' on April 28, 1989. Since its inception, the Institute has been one of the leading Institutions in the country for teaching, training, and research in the field of art and cultural heritage. The Institute has its main campus in Noida and is equipped with the state of art facilities for imparting quality education in the cultural sector.

➤ **How to reach the Institute**

The Indian Institute of Heritage (Noida Campus) is located approx. 34 km from Indira Gandhi International (IGI) airport and approx. 21 km from New Delhi railway station and 16km from Hazrat Nizamuddin Railway Station, New Delhi. The nearest metro station to the Campus is Noida Electronic City (Blue Line).

- **Indira Gandhi International (IGI) Airport**

**Route by Metro:**

Airport Express + Metro: Take the Airport Express Line to New Delhi station, then switch to the Blue Line towards Noida Electronic City.

**By Road:**

Taxi/Cab: Available directly from the airport. Travel time is typically 60-90 minutes, depending on traffic.

- **New Delhi Railway Station Route by**

**Metro:**

From New Delhi Railway Station, take the Yellow Line towards (Huda City Centre) Platform no. 1 and change at Rajiv Chowk to Blue Line metro towards Noida Electronic City. Exit at Noida Electronic City station, which is closest to the Indian Institute of Heritage (Noida Campus).

**By Road:**

Cabs are readily available at New Delhi Railway Station. The journey to the Indian Institute of Heritage (Noida Campus) typically takes 45-60 minutes, depending on traffic conditions.

- **Hazrat Nizamuddin Railway Station Route**

**by Metro:**

From Hazrat Nizamuddin Railway Station, take the Pink Line to Mayur Vihar Phase 1 and then transfer to the Blue Line and travel to Noida Electronic City station, which is nearest to the Indian Institute of Heritage.

**By Road:**

Cabs are easily available at Hazrat Nizamuddin Railway Station. The journey to the Indian Institute of Heritage approximately takes 30-45 minutes, depending on traffic conditions.
